

INCLEMENT WEATHER

School Districts in the following Counties:

Steuben County – Should MSD Steuben, Fremont Community, or Hamilton Community be delayed or cancelled, local or NEISEC buses serving Steuben County cooperative programs will delay or cancel according to the student's home and educating district implementing the inclement weather information.

DeKalb County – Should DeKalb Central, DeKalb Eastern, or Garrett-Keyser-Butler be delayed or cancelled, local or NEISEC buses serving DeKalb County cooperative programs will delay or cancel according to the student's home and educating district implementing the inclement weather information.

LaGrange County – Should Lakeland, Prairie Heights, or Westview be delayed or cancelled, local or NEISEC buses serving LaGrange County cooperative programs will delay or cancel according to the student's home and educating district implementing the inclement weather information.

Noble County – Should Central Noble or West Noble be delayed or cancelled, local or NEISEC buses serving Noble County cooperative programs will delay or cancel according to the student's home and educating district implementing the inclement weather information. ***Smith-Green School Corporation – should Smith-Green delay or cancel, NEISEC buses serving Smith-Green students will delay or cancel according to students' home and educating district.**

Parents are welcome to transport their student into the educating district if open even if the home district is closed or delayed. Students unable to attend school because transportation has been cancelled due to inclement weather will not be penalized for any work they may have missed and will have every opportunity to complete any work missed.

Buses serving more than one county will follow the inclement weather information of the NEISEC. (Co-op buses will not run in a district where school has been cancelled).
